

2020 SUREFIRE HORSE TRIALS SAFETY AGREEMENT

General Guidelines for All Attending

- All will be required to electronically submit in advance a signed Surefire Horse Trials Safety Agreement *and* USEF Amended Liability Release Form containing language related to Covid-19. Riders, trainers, coaches and owners must also submit the current USEF REVISED Entry Agreement Signature Page
- Anyone experiencing Covid-19 symptoms or anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the 14 days prior to the start of the competition will not be allowed on grounds
- Everyone on grounds must maintain a 6-foot social distance as much as possible
- Face masks are to be worn by everyone except when riders are mounted
- Sanitizing equipment for port-a-potties, warm-up jumps, etc. will be made available and those attending should also plan on bringing their own sanitizing products
- There will be drive-through check-ins for competitors and volunteers to minimize exposure
- Trailer parking will be distanced to ensure minimal contact between groups
- There will be no food, trade fair or water truck on property; plan accordingly
- Riders, grooms and trainers should stay with their group and not congregate with others
- Spectators and other non-essential people are strongly discouraged from attending

Riders, Trainers, Coaches, and Owners that will be on Grounds

- Required to electronically submit in advance a signed Surefire Horse Trials Safety Agreement *and* USEF Amended Liability Release Form *and* the current USEF REVISED Entry Agreement Signature Page
- Will enter and pay on-line in advance; any last-minute paperwork will be submitted to a designated “point person” to limit exposure to secretary and staff
- Will communicate with organizers, secretary and volunteers by radio or cellphone if at all possible to limit exposure
- Are responsible for providing their own masks and sanitizing supplies
- Must comply with requests made by staff, officials and volunteers to wear masks, to limit warm-up numbers, to not congregate, to sanitize commonly touched surfaces, and in general to follow best practices for limiting Covid-19 exposure

Officials and Staff

- Required to electronically submit in advance a signed Surefire Horse Trials Safety Agreement *and* USEF Amended Liability Release Form
- Will communicate by radio and remain in cars/golf carts/all-terrain vehicles when possible
- Will be provided with masks, gloves and sanitizing supplies
- Will sanitize clipboards, pens, walkie-talkies, competitor packets, utility vehicles and other commonly handled and shared equipment
- Will be provided with pre-packaged lunch, drinks and snacks

Volunteers

- Required to electronically submit in advance a signed Surefire Horse Trials Safety Agreement *and* USEF Amended Liability Release Form
- Will be provided with instructions and rules for volunteer positions in advance to limit need for “day of” instructions.
- Will be briefed on-line, by radio or while socially distanced
- Will be provided with masks, gloves and sanitizing supplies
- Will be provided with pre-packaged lunch, drinks and snacks
